## Lordship Fathers' Club Creative Writing Contest 2018 Submission Guidelines

Any student in grades 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>, who resides in Lordship, or currently attends Lordship School, may submit one entry on each of the specified topics, but may win no more than one prize. All entries are final; no revisions will be accepted.

Each entry must be:

- An original work, approximately 400-600 words, in English. Plagiarism, which includes the use of another's
  poetry, song lyrics, or ideas, without written permission or proper acknowledgment, will result in
  disqualification.
- Submitted to the Lordship School Main Office or the Lordship Fathers' Club by Monday, November 26th, 2018, along with a completed entry form (see below).
- Focused on one of three specified writing prompts as determined by the LFC.
- Word-processed, but may be hand written provided it is legible to the judges.

Entries will be scored on the following basis, each worth up to 25 points:

- 1. Proper grammar and punctuation
- 2. Development of the theme
- 3. Organization and clarity
- 4. Originality and style

The three winners at each grade level will be notified by December 14th, 2018 and awarded a prize, with first place winners possibly published in the LFC Newsletter and website (with parental permission, see below).
